Recommended for all patients age 5 and up, this technology allows us to view 200 degrees of the retina. Both patient and doctor will review the images on the computer. This method of examining and documenting the retina promotes early diagnosis of abnormal conditions, including holes, tears, bleeds, and cancer, which could prevent permanent vision loss. It also helps us monitor and detect changes from diabetes and high blood pressure, and we can share this information with your primary care physician. An additional benefit of retinal imaging is that we store the picture permanently and compare them against any changes in the future.
